- If your child is in nappies please could we remind you to provide nappies and wipes as appropriate, along with a change of clothing.
- Please ensure all your child's belongings are named, especially water bottles, sunhats and comfort toys, this stops any confusion and upset!
- We understand that children like to bring in comfort toys or items,
 please could you encourage your child to bring in one small item of low
 value that can fit in their bag, thank you. Please also be aware that we
 can not be responsible if the item gets lost or broken. We encourage
 all children to put their toys into their bags as soon as they are settled.
